Tricky words: energy, temperature

<u>Rays</u> of sunshine will <u>raise</u> the temperature of the earth. Most of the energy on earth is <u>gained</u> from the sun.

Wednesday (ei, ey) --- sounds like long a

vein, rein, heinous, beige, reign they, obey, grey, prey, survey, convey

tricky words: historian, detective, geographer

A historian is like a detective in that <u>they convey</u> the meanings of clues. Historians <u>rein</u> in clues from the past while geographers <u>survey</u> the land.

Thursday (eigh) and (ea) --- sounds like long a

weigh, sleigh, neighbor, freight, eight, weight, neighborhood great, steak, break

tricky words: series, circuit

If your <u>neighbor</u>'s holiday lights are in a series circuit, be careful not to <u>break</u> one. It costs <u>eight</u> dollars to replace the string of lights.
